Rules of the Pro group

1. Goals of the tournament

- 1.1. Promote a healthy and active lifestyle, familiarization with the Olympic sport of 3x3 basketball;
- 1.2. To facilitate the meeting of players, coaches and management representatives of the Latvian-Estonian basketball league, the National Basketball League and the Regional Basketball League clubs in an informal environment;
- 1.3. Determine the best teams and players of the "Rīgas Zeļļi Summer Fest Saulkrasti" (hereinafter - the Competition);
- 1.4. Contribute to the increase of Member States' ranking points in the International Basketball Federation (FIBA) World Ranking by registering the tournament and its results on the FIBA competition website "play.fiba3x3.com".

2. Organization and management

- 2.1. The competition is organized by "Rīgas Zeļļi" in cooperation with the association "Basketball club "Varenie runči"".

3. Time and place of the Competition

- 3.1. The Competition will take place on August 10, 2024 at the Saulkrasti 3x3 basketball court. In case of unfavorable weather conditions - in the Saulkrasti Sports Center;
- 3.2. The Competition will start at 12:00;
- 3.3. Address: Saulkrasti 3x3 basketball court (Saulkrasti, Raiņa street parking lot, nearest address Raiņa street 11 and Saulkrasti Sports Center (Saulkrasti, Smilšu street 3);
- 3.4. The organizers reserve the right to adjust the order of the Competition, the number of games, the times of the games.

4. Division of the Competition participants into groups

- 4.1. Pro group. The teams represent Latvian-Estonian Basketball League clubs. Clubs of the

National Basketball League and the Regional Basketball League can apply for special invitations ("Wild Cards").

5. Participation fee

5.1. Participation in the Competition is free.

6. Registration and application

- 6.1. Clubs of the Latvian-Estonian basketball league, after receiving an invitation from "Rīgas Zeļļi", apply for teams to the e-mail address of "Rīgas Zeļļi" representative Beāte Kampare (beate.kampare@gmail.com);
- 6.2. Clubs of the National Basketball League and the Regional Basketball League apply for a special invitation ("Wild Card") to the e-mail address of "Rīgas Zeļļi" representative Beāte Kampare (beate.kampare@gmail.com);
- 6.3. Registration of club teams of the Latvian-Estonian basketball league until August 1 at 17:00. Registration of players until August 8 at 17:00;
- 6.4. National Basketball League clubs applications for Wild Card are accepted until August 1 at 17:00. They will be reviewed until August 2 at 17:00, sending information to applicants.

7. Team composition

- 7.1. The team is allowed to apply for the Competition from three to four players;
- 7.2. All players must have a player profile on the FIBA 3x3 basketball competition platform "play.fiba3x3.com" before submitting a team.

8. Forms of players

- 8.1. Participation in Competitions for team players in the same uniforms with numbers. It is also necessary to provide same numbered game shirts of other colors.

9. Competition procedure

- 9.1. The competition takes place in accordance with the FIBA 3x3 basketball rules, allowing deviations at certain points;
- 9.2. Games are primarily played with "Wilson 3x3" size 6 official 3x3 basketballs;
- 9.3. The order of play of the competition is determined depending on the number of registered teams;
- 9.4. At least three games are provided for each team at each stage (Competition organizers do not guarantee teams' attendance at games);
- 9.5. Division of teams into subgroups is determined according to FIBA ranking;

9.6. The preliminaries determine the teams that qualify for the elimination tournament.

10. Evaluation of results

10.1. In the preliminary group, the higher place is taken by the team with the greater number of victories;

10.2. If two teams have the same number of wins, the head-to-head result is taken into account;

10.3. If three or more teams have the same number of wins (including the number of wins in mutual games), then the higher place is taken by the team that scored more points in the subgroup tournament;

10.4. If all three scores are equal, the team with more rating points at the start of the tournament is ranked higher.

11. Awarding

11.1. The first three place winners team participants are awarded with medals;

11.2. The winners of the first three places receive a team cup;

11.3. The best player and three players of the symbolic team receives souvenirs.

12. Information

12.1. Information about the Competition is published in "Rīgas Zeļļi" social networks and in the "3x3basketballdealer.lv/rigaszeļli" section of the "3x3BasketballDealer" website;

12.2. The results of the competition are published on the FIBA website "play.fiba3x3.com".

13. Other issues

13.1. Each participant of the competition is responsible for his own state of health.

13.2. All issues that are not provided for in these Rules are resolved by mutual agreement.

13.3. If participants violate the Rules, they are disqualified from the Competition.

13.4. The obtained personal data will be used and stored in accordance with the procedure provided in the laws and regulations of the Republic of Latvia.

13.5. Photos and videos taken by the organizers during the competition will be used in the public materials of the competition.
